E1 OUTSIDE THE MARKET/ DAY

WE LISTEN TO MUSIC WITH LATIN MODERN RHYTHMS, THE VOLUME STARTS LOUD AT FIRST AND STARTS TO LOWER WHILE THE NARRATOR, *MRS BLANQUI* (50), A WOMAN WHO SELLS VEGETABLES AT THE MARKET STARTS TO TELL US, EVERY TIME WE VISIT HER STALL, HOW THE STORY OF OUR PROTAGONISTS IS DEVELOPING. SFX: MARKET SOUNDS

MRS BLANQUI

Come in ask, do you want something, will you buy something, what can we give you? We have tomatoes, cucumber, cauliflower... you have never been here before, right? Well, I am MRS BLANQUI, I have my vegetable stall here and I am also the official information service for everything that happens in the neighborhood. Really? You don't believe me?

Well, for example, look at that girl who is there, the one with the red blouse, she is Lupita, good girl see, she is the daughter of Mrs. Albita, an old woman who is alone only with her, you should see how they take care of each other.

But at present the girl is very sad, you should see how she cries...Mmmm!... if you do not know what happened, yes of course, I will tell you. Everything started when Lupita went to visit her friend Chonita ...

Cut A:

E2 INSIDE OF CHONITAS HOUSE / NIGHT

WE CAN HEAR WATER BOILING AND A BABY CRYING. CHONITA (30) IS TRYING TO PUT SOME ORDER IN HER HOUSE WHILE COOKING DINNER AND LOOKING AFTER HER THREE CHILDREN: MAICOL (5) BRANDON (3) AND KIMBERLY (1)

CHONITA

(COUGH) Children, pick up your toys, I already stepped on a car and I almost opened my head. Maicol! Brandon! Please pick up your toys.

SFX: THE DOOR SOUNDS

LUPITA

Excuse me...

CHONITA

Come in Lupita (COUGH), please excuse me for the mess, but these kids have not picked up their toys, be careful where you step.

LUPITA

Do not worry. And the baby?

CHONITA

She is there asking for her bottle; wait a moment so I can attend to the princess. Here Kimberly, here is your bottle, do not cry anymore.

SFX: THE BABY STOPS CRYING

LUPITA

Chonita, why is the house so full of smoke? Let's open the windows so the air can come in, this is not good for that cough and for the kids.

SFX: SOUNDS OF WINDOWS OPENING.

CHONITA

Oh, yes, I am tired of coughing.

LUPITA

It is because you are cooking with an open fire inside the house...

CHONITA

Open fire?

LUPITA

That is what you call it when you cook with firewood inside the house. Tomorrow I will bring you a flyer about the improved stoves that we are selling at the company. With these stoves the smoke does not stay inside...

CHONITA

All right, thank you. But please sit down Lupita.

Tell me about your life? How is your mom doing?

LUPITA

Ah, well my mom is doing good, they told her her heart is getting better, she went to her doctor's appointment last week and he told her to continue with her treatment.

CHONITA

Ah that is good. And you mamaita?

Look, you are letting your life go by just taking care of your mom and working.

LUPITA

Ah no, you exaggerate!

CHONITA

Ah yes, at your age I already had Maicol and I was pregnant with Brandon.

LUPITA

Ah, but that is different. I work hard studying and at such time my brothers started to get married and I stayed taking care of my mother...anyway...

CHONITA

And there is no one around that has caught your eye?...

....Ah, I know that silence - tell me everything.

LUPITA

There is not much to tell,

Yesterday something happened at work...

E3 INSIDE THE OFFICE/ DAY

WE HEAR TELEPHONE RINGING AND PEOPLE TALKING IN AN OFFICE ENVIRONMENT AND WORKING AT DESKS.

MR. JUSTO

Lupita, Lupita... can you please come here for a moment?

LUPITA

Excuse me, yes Mr. Justo.

MR. JUSTO

This is Justo, my son.

LUPITA

(VERY IMPRESSED BY JUSTO) A pleasure.

JUSTO

(FASCINATED BY LUPITA) Likewise.

MR. JUSTO

Justo just graduated from university and he has lots of ideas to help people learn about improved stoves. There are many people who get sick because they cook with firewood inside the house and it is necessary that they get to know this alternative.

LUPITA

Ah yes, just..

JUSTO

Yes?

LUPITA

(TONGUE TIED) No...I mean that I have a friend just like that, that has a cough that won't go away because of that.

JUSTO

Ah...

MR. JUSTO

Please give my son all the information you know regarding the people that should be buying our stoves, and tell him how the stoves work, and update him, by telling him what we do here.

LUPITA

My pleasure Mr. Justo.

Cut A:

E4 INSIDE OF CHONITAS HOUSE / NIGHT

CHONITA

And is he good looking? (COUGH)

LUPITA

Ay, Chonita your question.

CHONITA

You liked him right Lupita, I know that look...

you should talk to him, tell him to go out somewhere...

LUPITA

What? Never...

CHONITA

I will tell you what to do...

E5: OUTSIDE THE MARKET/ DAY

SFX: MARKET SOUNDS

MRS. BLANQUI

And so, Chonita advised Lupita how to find love, but she never imagined how hard it would be....

CLIENT

Mrs. Blanqui, and how much for the radish?

MRS. BLANQUI

Ay, I am sorry I have to keep working. Come another day and I will tell you what Chinita told Lupita and what they did. All right, good bye, hope everything goes well.

(END)

SFX: MARKET SOUNDS

MRS. BLANQUI

We have carrots, chili, plantains! Come in, ask....

Look, who is here again to say hello... How is your life?

Well I am here always working since there is no other way.

And do not speak, I already told you about Lupita and that she met

The son of her boss, Justito, son of Mr. Justo.

Ok, what is his name, he really caught her eye...

Ah, we could see by the way she walked that the girl was smitten by love.

And so, she, at night

After work, went to talk with her friend Chonita to tell her the last

Minute gossip about the matter...

CUT A:

E7 INSIDE CHONITA'S HOUSE / NIGHT

WE CAN HEAR THE KIDS PLAYING, CHONITA IS CHANGING THE BABY'S DIAPER. SHE IS COUGHING

Chonita, that cough has not gone away

Neither from Brandon and nor you.

Little by little everyone is getting sick because you are cooking with an open fire inside the house...

CHONITA

But (she coughs) what other way do I have then?

Switch to gas?

(COUGHS)

LUPITA

Well we have to look into that, it is not a bad idea, for now, I brought you the flyer of the Improved Cook Stoves that we sell with Mr. Justo, and look; I give you my word that they are really good, not for nothing.

CHONITA

Ok, leave it there, I will talk with Peter Table

LUPITA

Who?

CHONITA

Pedro Meza, mi husband, that is the way I call him just to annoy him.

He is very hard headed, he should be called Fred Flintstone, I will have to convince him to get one of those Improved Clean Cook Stoves.

LUPITA

This Chonita

CHONITA

(MAKING UP A PLAN) How about you come over tomorrow,

But a bit late so he is already home,

And we talk about the Improved Clean- Cook Stoves loudly,

Like we do not want the thing, but start to convince him.

LUPITA

(WITH COMPLICITY) Good, let's try, have we nothing to lose.

CHONITA

Good, and talking about "nothing to lose"

Did you tell Mr. Justo's son what I told you too?

LUPITA

NO!

CHONITA

And why not Lupita?

I advise you for nothing

LUPITA

I was never going to say to him

"Listen to me Justo let's give us a try"

CHONITA

Why not? Pedro told me, "Chonita you are very pretty."

And look...three kids and six years of marriage, here we are.

LUPITA

Yes, but no, I could not do it

WE HEAR BRANDON ONE OF CHINOTAS KIDS WITH A COUGHING ATTACK

CHONITA

Ah God, Brandon is coughing again.

He did not heal; he has already taken three bottles of medicine

LUPITA

It is urgent that we talk to your caveman

CHONITA

Yes look, so, you have not talked that much with Justo Junior?

LUPITA

A little...(sighing)

CHONITA

And what does he tell you?

E8 INSIDE THE OFFICE/ DAY

WE HEAR TELEPHONE RINGING AND PEOPLE TALKING IN AN OFFICE ENVIRONMENT AND WORKING AT DESKS.

JUSTO

So I am in the hands of the best saleswoman of the company?

LUPITA

Who? Me? No...

JUSTO

That is what my father told me, that you are his best saleswoman and because of you,

Many families have Improved Clean- Cook Stoves in their homes.

LUPITA

Ah it's because we have one at home and well, my mother's friends and other neighbors have seen it and they end up being convinced.

JUSTO

That is what I want - to inspire others so they can improve their quality of life.

I think we have a lot in common.

LUPITA

Looks like we do.

KNOCK ON THE DOOR AND THEY OPEN

TERE

Excuse me, Mr. Justo junior,

I did not want to interrupt.

JUSTO

Just call me Justo, Tere,

Mr. Justo is my father.

I am, Justo, nothing else.

TERE

Okay, "Justo nothing else"

They called Lupita here at the office,

They said her mother got sick and they said she needs to go see her.

LUPITA

My mother! Can I leave now?

JUSTO

Yes of course, I will take you.

LUPITA

Ah no, how embarrassing.

JUSTO

Do not be embarrassed.

It's an emergency.

Let's go. (they leave the office)

E9 OUTSIDE THE MARKET/ DAY

SFX: MARKET SOUNDS

MRS. BLANQUI

And she took her.

The girl was more worried about something else,

But....

CLIENT

Mrs. Blanqui, do you have beets?

MRS. BLANQUI

Yes I do, I am coming.

Ay, I am sorry I have to keep working. Come any other day when you can and I will tell you what happened to Mrs. Albita, Chonita and her husband, and Lupita and the *cabalito*, I mean Justito.

Ay, see you soon....

(END)

SFX: MARKET SOUNDS

MRS. BLANQUI

We have onions, green beans, parsley!

Ay! Hello, how are you? Look at you, you always come at the best time, today I have to tell you what happened to Lupitas mom. Do you remember she got sick?

The boy, Justo, took Lupita to her house because of the emergency to see her mother...and you will never guess what happened.

CUT A:

E11 INSIDE LUPITAS HOME/ AFTERNOON

We listen to a whistle of a pot over the stove. The door of the house opens.

LUPITA

MOM! MOM!

Do not walk into the light!

MRS. ALBITA

Here I am daughter,

What light are you talking about?

LUPITA

Mom Mom

I thought you had left us...

MRS. ALBITA

Where?

LUPITA

To heaven.

JUSTO

Or to some other place.

MRS. ALBITA

Ah?

JUSTO

I mean...how are you feeling Mrs. Albita?

MRS. ALBITA

Baby, who is he?

LUPITA

He is the son of my boss, he brought me as a favor so I could be here faster.

MRS. ALBITA

Nice to meet you, young man.

JUSTO

It's my pleasure.

LUPITA

Mom, but you seem well, at the office they said you were sick...

MRS. ALBITA

I was daughter, that is why I called your office.

It was less than five minutes ago that the pain went away.

JUSTO

But, Mrs. Albita, we are going to take you to the hospital just to check.

MRS. ALBITA

No, young man, I feel better.

LUPITA

Are you sure mom?

JUSTO

Let's go, it is best to be sure.

MRS. ALBITA

"No," I said!

JUSTO

I will pay for the medical consultation, do not worry...

MRS. ALBITA

Ah, then okay, take me.

Let's go baby.

LUPITA

Ah Thank you very much Justo.

THEY LEAVE THE HOUSE

E12 OUTSIDE THE MARKET/ DAY

MRS. BLANQUI, CONTINUES TO TELL US THE GOSSIP OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD

MRS. BLANQUI

The three of them left in the car, but Mrs. Albita made them get vegetables, and also they went to the bakery, and the butcher shop...taking advantage of the car. Then they went to the hospital.

While this was happening, Chonita on her part, was left alone with her plan to give hints to her husband in regards to improved clean stoves.

E13 INSIDE CHONITAS HOUSE/NIGHT

CHONITA WAS LEFT WAITING ON LUPITA

CHONITA

This Lupita never came, I will have to face the hard head on my own ...well, either way.

PEDRO

Chonita, do you have more beans?

CHONITA

Yes, I will give you some more.

PEDRO

I'll only have more because I am very hungry ... but they taste a little weird.

CHONITA

Of course, they are from today passed

PEDRO

Huh?

CHONITA

From today - eight days ago

PEDRO

AH that's why.

CHONITA

Look, Pedro, we need to get an improved stove

PEDRO

Ah no, if that means we have to spend no,

We are doing just fine

CHONITA

Listen to me, the improved stoves will help us spend less; we will use less firewood and

We will spend less in medicines

PEDRO

Mmmm keep talking...

CHONITA

You like the part of spending less, right? Look;

Two pieces of firewood can cook a lot, since you place them in the stove and so they are shut-in, and we will also save money in medicine, the kids and I will not get sick anymore from cooking with open fire...

PEDRO

Open fire?

CHONITA

(very know-it-all) that is how you call it when you cook with fire inside the house and it is not shut in, in an enclosed space like it is with an improved stove. And also with such stoves, all the smoke leaves the house, it does not stay inside.

PEDRO

What a good idea!

CHONITA

The improved stove?

PEDRO

NO, not staying inside because there is too much smoke here.

See you.... (he leaves the house)

CHONITA

Pedrooooo!!!

E14 OUTSIDE THE MARKET/ DAY

SFX: MARKET SOUNDS

MRS. BLANQUI

So she has not yet convinced Pedro but next time I will tell you everything. Bye....

(END)

I know you are not here to buy vegetables,

You are here to know what happened with Lupita, with Chonita, with Justo...with Pedro, I know.

Alright look, you remember that they took Mrs. Albita to the hospital because she got sick, well, the doctor scolded her...

CUT A:

E16 INSIDE THE HOSPITAL CLINIC/ AFTERNOON/ NIGHT

DOCTOR

Mrs Albita, I have two pieces of news for you, a bad one and a good one.

MRS. ALBITA

Ah Jesus! What is the good one?

DOCTOR

That you did not suffer a heart attack,

Nothing to do with your heart.

LUPITA

Ay that is good! My mom has suffered from that in the past few years and we were Sad that she continues to be sick.

DOCTOR

And the bad one doctor?

DOCTOR

What happened is that you fainted possibly due to inhaling carbon dioxide for a long period of time.

LUPITA

That cannot be possible doctor, in our house we have an improved stove.

DOCTOR

Ah, those that have a chimney that takes the smoke of the firewood outside the house.

With those you not only avoid risk in your health but also you take care of the environment.

MRS. ALBITA

And if that was not it, what can it be? Wait, wait...

LUPITA

What happened mom?

MRS. ALBITA

Oh, I remember now,

I was not at home,

I was at Maritza's house

Talking with her while she was cooking lunch.

LUPITA

She cooks with open fire...

DOCTOR

Uy, yes, with the fire lit inside and with the whole house full of smoke, of course you were going to get sick.

CUT A:

E17 OUTSIDE MARKET / DAY

MARKET SOUNDS

MRS. BLANQUI, SHE CONTINUES TO TELL US THE GOSSIP OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD

MRS. BLANQUI

Well, to keep the story short, they took Mrs. Albita back to the house.

CUT A:

E18 INSIDE JUSTO CAR/ NIGHT

MRS. ALBITA, JUSTO AND LUPITA ARE GOING BACK.

MRS. ALBITA

Oh, JUSTO, thank you

LUPITA

Yes, Justo how embarrassing.

JUSTO

No shame, I am here to help a co worker

MRS. ALBITA

And a single one....

LUPITA

MOM!

MRS. ALBITA

What is wrong, daughter?

I am not saying anything wrong, right Justo?

JUSTO

No, do not have any shame

MRS. ALBITA

And you, are you single?

You look single.

LUPITA

Mom, stop!

JUSTO,

Yes, I am single.

MRS. ALBITA

Look Justo, since we already went to get food, come in to our house and we all can eat, and then I can tell you how wonderful Lupita is.

LUPITA

How embarrassing Mom, I am sure Justo has other things to do. Right?

JUSTO

Not really, I will be glad to go in for a while and eat.

E19 OUTSIDE THE MARKET / DAY

SFX: MARKET SOUNDS

MRS. BLANQUI

But not everything was going to be pure happiness,

That night, a mysterious character wandered around the neighborhood.

CUT A:

E20 INSIDE JUSTO CAR/ NIGHT

MRS. ALBITA, JUSTO AND LUPITA WERE PARKING THE CAR IN FRONT OF THE HOUSE

JUSTO

Look, wait do not get out of the car, there's someone outside, they might be dangerous...

MRS. ALBITA

Daughter, is that...

LUPITA

Macario!

Yayaiii! This got better, Macario is Lupita's ex-boyfriend

(END)

SFX: MARKET SOUNDS

MRS. BLANQUI

Will you take something? do you want something? what can we give you? There is cauliflower,
there is broccoli, there is avocado!
Look ripe avocado, perfect for your guacamole.

Let me tell you that I already installed in my house one of those Improved Clean- Cook Stoves, that reduce the smoke from inside the house... Yes, one of those that are ecofriendly. Even the taste of my food improved after removing the smoke.

Lupita convinced me.

Mmmmm, I was going to tell you something about Lupita....

MACARIO

LUPITA

Don't call me "princess" What are you doing outside the house?

MACARIO

Well, I'm waiting for you, so I can give you an opportunity to say you are sorry and get back together with me.

LUPITA

Me? Asking for your forgiveness?

MACARIO

Yup, for breaking up with this hunk.

LUPITA

Oh please Macario.

MACARIO

Who is that rich looking boy in the car with your mom?

LUPITA

He is my coworker and he is also the son of my boss, from the place where we sell the Improved Clean-cook stoves. So please, behave.

MACARIO

So Lupita, you are cheating on me with your boss' son.

LUPITA

Stop it, I'm not cheating on anyone nor am I having something with someone.

MRS ALBITA AND JUSTO APROACH

JUSTO

Are you having any problems Lupita, is this young man bothering you?

MACARIO

This young man has a name, and my name is Macario, I was Lupita's boyfriend before she had bad taste in men.

JUSTO

We will see in the end, if she chooses the past or the future.

MACARIO

We will see about that, Little Prince, no one makes fun of me.

MRS ALBITA

Macario!

MACARIO

Yes Mrs. Albita?

MRS ALBITA

That's enough!

MACARIO

But Mrs. Albita.... I just wanted...

MRS ALBITA

Good night Macario, if you have something to say to my daughter it would be in the daytime and at a decent hour.

MACARIO

As you say Mrs. Albita, goodbye Lupita, but you're going to regret this, when you realize that his money doesn't compare to everything I gave to you, you will realize that you can't buy happiness, is better to have a sincere love than to live in loneliness.

MRS ALBITA

Ok, bye.

MACARIO LEAVES IN HIS MOTORCYCLE

JUSTO

That was awkward.

LUPITA

I'm sorry Justo, Macario is an ex-boyfriend, in the beginning he was very polite, but then he started to be abusive.

MRS ALBITA

Oh yes young man, if you knew how my baby wouldn't stop crying because of him.

JUSTO

I can imagine...

MRS ALBITA

But for you she only sighs instead.

LUPITA

MOM!

Son, something that life has taught me, is time is valuable, and you shouldn't waste it waiting. Now, go get her, tiger!

JUSTO

That is exactly what I'll...

MR JUSTO

What's happening?

JUSTO
